



A SEVERE WEATHER OUTBREAK IS LIKELY TODAY FOR ALL OF CENTRAL ALABAMA. STRONG...LONG LIVED TORNADOES...DAMAGING WINDS...AND VERY LARGE HAIL ARE ALL POSSIBLE. THE GREATEST THREAT THROUGH NOON WILL BE AREAS WEST OF 65 AND NORTH OF INTERSTATE 20. THE THREAT WILL THEN EXTEND ACROSS ALL OF CENTRAL ALABAMA DURING THE AFTERNOON AND CONTINUE AT LEAST THROUGH MIDNIGHT.

LOCALIZED TORRENTIAL RAINFALL IS ALSO POSSIBLE TODAY AND TONIGHT. A FEW INCHES OF RAINFALL MAY OCCUR IN A SHORT PERIOD OF TIME. ADDITIONALLY...MORE THAN ONE STORM MAY AFFECT THE SAME AREA. THIS MAY PRODUCE SOME LOCALIZED FLASH FLOODING.

EVEN OUTSIDE OF THUNDERSTORM AREAS...STRONG GRADIENT WINDS ARE ALSO EXPECTED. SUSTAINED WINDS OF 15 TO 25 MPH ALONG WITH HIGHER GUSTS UP TO 35 MPH ARE EXPECTED.
