

## **Governor Bentley, State EMA to Hold News Conference Updating Preparations for Isaac**

CLANTON – Governor Robert Bentley and Alabama Emergency Management Agency Director Art Faulkner will hold a news conference Tuesday to discuss the latest on Isaac and the storm's expected impact on Alabama. Governor Bentley and Director Faulkner will be joined by representatives of the National Weather Service and the American Red Cross.

Tuesday's news conference will begin at 5:00 p.m. at the Alabama EMA Emergency Operations Center in Clanton. Currently, the EOC is at Level 1 activation in preparation for Isaac.

A live satellite uplink, webcast, and audio bridge of Tuesday's news conference will be provided.
